

ZAMBIA VISA Information

If one is not a citizen of a country that is exempted from having to apply for a Zambia visa, then one must obtain a visa either at the port of entry or at a Zambian Mission abroad.

Note that countries in blue require VISA prior to travel

Travel Requirements

All people travelling to Zambia will need:

- ✓ Passport valid for a least 6 months from your date of entry
- ✓ Return ticket to your country if flying into Zambia
- ✓ Funds to cover your stay
- ✓ At least two blank pages in your passport to fit the required entry visa
